### **Our Stevens Community is:**

- At Stevens, 33% of our students qualify for free and reduced meals — a figure often underreported — so we proudly participate in the Everyone Eats Free program to ensure no child goes hungry.
- Located in one of Seattle's more affluent neighborhoods and serving students from each rung of the socio-economic ladder, our "tiny but mighty" PTA works tirelessly to raise funds that support every student, ensuring equal access to opportunities and a caring school community.
- At Stevens, students who need extra support thrive within our inclusive model: they learn alongside peers in a homeroom classroom while also accessing a dedicated homebase classroom for specialized services and individualized supports, ensuring both belonging and the targeted instruction they need to succeed.

# **Annual Spend**

#### Additional Staff | \$65,000

 Reading Interventionist, Instructional Assistant, Math Tutor

#### Classroom Grants | \$23,500

- School supplies for all students
- Classroom grants for every homeroom and special classrooms
- Field Trips

#### Community Events | \$21,500

- Free for all students to strenghten community
- All PTA & school meetings include childcare & kids dinner to ensure most families can attend

#### **Equity Fund | \$14,050**

 We send 10% of the funds we raise each year to CANNSPA, which distributes them to other local public schools with greater needs.

### **Enrichment | \$16,000**

- Outdoor education, assemblies, etc
- Afterschool program with "pay what you can" model

### PTA Admin | \$8,300

- Website, Accounting, Payment Fees, Insurance,
- Dues (so PTA membership is free to all caregivers)
- Childcare at PTA meetings


